This study is to encourage us all not to be weary or tired in doing good. As we continue to do this it has a profound effect in our lives, one of which is that it assures our hearts before God, if we do it through love and not selfish motives. What is good? There is a Greek word for good which is agathos. Describes that which being good in its character or constitution is <u>beneficial in its effect</u>.
